(Material cost plus labor cost) Plus overhead costs

Car Cross $\$0.90 + ?(\$1.25 = \$2.15 \times 2 = \4.30

Necklace cross $\$0.12 + \$0.07 + \$0.75 = \$0.94 \times 2 = \$1.88$

Assembly steps

Humble Cross

1. Preparing
 - a. Cut the ties in half
 - b. Clean out pendant loop for twine with the tip of the craft knife
 - c. Remove rough spots from pendants with craft knife
 - d. Cut twine into bundles of 10, each one 3 feet long
2. Cleaning
 - a. Soak crosses in mild soapy water
(Use hypoallergenic soap)
 - b. Rub crosses thoroughly to remove residue
 - c. Move crosses to clean water for rinsing
 - d. Stir crosses thoroughly to rinse
 - e. Remove and dry crosses
 - f. Soak twine bundle in mild soapy water
 - g. Remove twine from soapy water squeeze water out
 - h. Move twine to clean water for rinsing
 - i. Gently stir twine then remove and squeeze water out
 - j. Dry twine by hanging over a support
3. Assembling
 - a. Tie stopper knot in one end of twine
 - b. Thread pendant
 - c. Tie stopper knot in other end of twine

- d. Tie square knot and pull tight
- e. Trim ends of twine

4. Packaging

- a. Loop twine around two fingers and then wrap tie around loops
- b. Secure tag with end of tie
- c. Put in the package, squeeze air out and close
- d. Pray over each cross with the prayer on the tag plus ask for any other blessings you'd like
- e. Collect 7 packages and put it into a bag
