Peace: A sense of wholeness and tranquility that comes from trusting in God's sovereignty.

Patience: The ability to endure trials, delays, or suffering with perseverance and grace.

Kindness: A disposition of compassion and generosity toward others, reflecting God's kindness.

Goodness: A commitment to moral integrity and actively doing what is right.

Faithfulness: Loyalty and trustworthiness in relationship to God and others.

Gentleness: A spirit of humility and mildness in dealing with others.

Self-Control: The ability to exercise restraint over one's desires, emotions, and actions.
